

LET'S GET MATHS MOVING! PART 2 - TEACHING ACTIVITY

I went to the supermarket and I bought...

- Begin with the class stood in a circle.
- The first person in the circle says "I went to the supermarket and I bought _____." Fill the gap with any item you like and add an action. The action does not have to match the item.
 - **E.g.** I went to the supermarket and I bought broccoli. *Hands in the sky*
- The next person then repeats the first sentence and adds another item and action.
 - **E.g.** "I went to the supermarket and I bought broccoli *hands in the sky* and ice cream *touch your toes*"
- Continue like this until everyone in the class has had a go. The final person will have to list all the items and perform all the actions!
- Extension: Try to create a list where the pattern being followed is alphabetical (apples, broccoli, carrots etc.). Choose whichever elements you think will work best for you and your class. You're still creating a pattern!
